

VIRGINIA: IN THE CIRCUIT COURT OF MADISON COUNTY

IN RE: CLERK'S OFFICE – LODGED WILLS

ORDER

On June 21, 1960, the Court authorized the use of the Clerk's Office of Madison County as a place where any person, who was a resident of Madison County or his attorney may, during their lifetime, lodge for safekeeping with the Clerk of the Court, any will executed by such person, pursuant to Section 64.2-409, of the Code of Virginia.

Due to storage constraints and the liability of safe keeping, the Clerk has requested that she no longer accept wills for safekeeping effective January 1, 2025.

Therefore, the Court Orders that the Order entered on June 21, 1960 authorizing the Clerk to lodge wills for safekeeping be rescinded and effective January 1, 2025, the Clerk will no long lodge residents wills for safekeeping in her office.
