

# JUDICIAL INQUIRY AND REVIEW COMMISSION



A complaint may be filed by anyone and all matters are confidential unless the Commission files a formal complaint against the judge in the Supreme Court of Virginia.

The Judicial Inquiry and Review Commission was created by the Constitution of Virginia to investigate complaints of judicial misconduct or serious mental or physical disabilities that interfere with a judge's duties.

The Commission does not investigate matters of judicial discretion, such as the rulings and decisions of the judge.

The Commission cannot change any ruling or finding.
