

MADISON COUNTY CIRCUIT COURT
COMMUNITY SERVICE PROGRAM
Virginia Code §19.2-354(C)

The Circuit Court of Madison County hereby establishes a program to provide an optional method to discharge all or a part of the fine or costs imposed by earning credits for the performance of community service work before or after imprisonment.

Under this program, a defendant who is allowed to perform community service shall earn credits at the rate of \$12.00 per hour. Community service work shall be performed for any recognized governmental agency within the County of Madison under the supervision of a person to be designated in the order providing for community service under this program and the defendant cannot have received any compensation or pay for the work performed. A written record shall be maintained specifying the number of hours completed. The work site and the name of the supervisor shall be shown on the record. Credit for community service work shall be applied first to the payment of all court costs and then to the payment of any fine imposed on the defendant. Credit for community service work will not be applied towards restitution.

Any supervisor designated in the Court Order shall report to the Clerk of this Court unsatisfactory work performance which shall be immediately brought to the attention of this Court.
